

Junaluskans Board Meeting

Jan Lemasters called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m.

Opening Prayer. Gary Phillips offered an opening prayer.

Approval of minutes. Jeff Mickle reported that the minutes from May 6, 2026, were emailed and no changes were received. Gary Phillips moved their adoption. Judy LaFountaine seconded. They were adopted.

Treasurer's report. Frank Dunnewind's reported that at the end of April, we have received \$19,256.42; we have spent \$2,980.97. Our balance at the end is \$16,275.45.

Chairpersons

Membership – Margaret Amick reported that a year ago, our membership was 489. Now it is 428. Discussion ensued about the possibility of doing an audit of Frank Stith's email list. Lynette Stewart and Jan Lemasters will meet with Frank Stith. Ken Howle offered to help with data on who paid for membership last year compared to this year. (Frank Dunnewind said this will not include people who paid cash.)

Spiritual Committee – Gary Phillips reported that the next event is at Inspiration Point on July 21. Future hymn sings will be at 6:30.

Scholarship – Gary Phillips reported that applications have been sent out.

Travel and Hike –George Shepherd said he will not lead next year. There will be a hike on June 24.

Old Business

- **Online registration.** The demonstration for our review has been delayed until our next meeting.
- **Flea Market** – June 13. Judy LaFountaine announced that Friday workers should not park by Wellness by the Lake. Lunch will be at 12:00 Friday, free for volunteers. Volunteers are not allowed to shop until 1:00 Friday. Donations on Friday received between 9:00 and 12:00. Todd Stewart has a fourth truck lined up. There will be three credit card stations, marked by balloons. A separate checking account has been set up, categorized according to the departments. The minimum charge will be \$20.00 per area. ck. People will get a voucher for each credit card purchase, to take to the credit card station, and then returned back to the department to pick up their purchased goods. Departments will need a space to hold the items while the purchasers are getting their card transactions. Use of credit cards has not been advertised; this year is a "soft opening" for credit card use.

New Business
